3rd Week of November: Burning spirituality (2 Kings 2:6~11)

Welcome

■ Text: 2 Kings 2:6~11

6 Then Elijah said to him, "Stay here; the Lord has sent me to the Jordan." And he replied, "As surely as the Lord lives and as you live, I will not leave you." So the two of them walked on. 7 Fifty men from the company of the prophets went and stood at a distance, facing the place where Elijah and Elisha had stopped at the Jordan. 8 Elijah took his cloak, rolled it up and struck the water with it. The water divided to the right and to the left, and the two of them crossed over on dry ground.9 When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?" "Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit," Elisha replied.10 "You have asked a difficult thing," Elijah said, "yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be yours—otherwise, it will not." 11 As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.

■ Introduction

Spirituality is not just about casting out demons, speaking in tongues, and prophesying. Spirituality is to be controlled by the Holy Spirit, transformed into the person of Christ, and to do the power of God. Spirituality is to be controlled by the Holy Spirit and to obey the Holy Spirit.

And a personal change must occur through Jesus Christ. Just as the book of James emphasizes works rather than faith, it was disparaged as a straw epistle by the theology that 'salvation is received by faith'. However, we must think again about the book of James.

(James 2:26) "Faith without works is dead, just as a body without a soul is dead."

If you are a true Christian, you must see a change in your personal life in Christ.

Today's text is the story of Elisha and his teacher, Elijah. When his teacher, Elijah, ascended to heaven, Elisha followed Elijah to the end. Elisha longed to receive the inspiration of Elijah's first temple, and followed Elijah from Gilgal to Bethel, then to Jericho and Jordan, saying, "I will not leave you," and finally received the inspiration of the first piece. I hope that we too will receive the power and grace of the Word in the word.





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■ Observation Question: What are the four steps to achieving double spirituality?

Answer 1. Burning spirituality begins with emptiness.

Spirituality begins with emptying of oneself before God, to have spirituality, you must first empty yourself before seeking grace and power. When Jesus called His disciples, they threw away their nets and chased after Him.

(Matthew 4:20) "Immediately they left their nets and followed Jesus."

However, the rich young man in Matthew 19 kept all the laws, but when Jesus said, "Go and sell your possessions and give them to the poor" (Matthew 19:21), they were filled with wealth, so they heard these words and were sorrowful, so they could not follow Jesus.

Spirituality can gain spiritual strength when I humble myself and let go of myself. (Galatians 5:24) "The people of Christ Jesus crucified their passions and desires with their flesh."

Passions means emotional impulse, lust, passion, and passion. Desires are the desire to satisfy oneself more than God with wrong desires and sinful desires. The desire to satisfy one's own desires makes people arrogant. We must crucify that passion. Please wash and empty it with the blood of Jesus Christ.

☆ Application Question 1

- 1) What are the passions and desires that I should be crucified?
- 2) What are the spiritual habits that I need or need to practice being filled with the Holy Spirit?

Answer 2. Burning spirituality is restored by filling.

After emptying ourselves, we must fill ourselves with the Holy Spirit. Christianity is a religion of experience, so we must fill our hearts and achieve restoration through the experience of the Holy Spirit. Just as God's life is breathed into the dry bones of the valley of Ezechol, we must fill them with the Holy Spirit, just as the dry bones become God's army (Ezekiel 37:1~10).

When an unclean demon came out of a demon-possessed person, it was not filled with the Spirit of God, so it became even more evil.

(Matthew $12:44\sim45$) "Then he said, 'I will return to the house from which I came out,' and when I came, the house was empty, burned down, and repaired, 45 and he went and brought seven demons who were more evil than me, and dwelt there, and his later condition became worse than before."

Please be filled with the Holy Spirit.

(Ephesians 5:18) "...Only be filled with the Holy Spirit."



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☆ Application Question 2

1) What must an emptied soul guard against so that it is not filled again with worldly things?

Answer 3. We must stand and stay awake.

The apostle Paul tells us to yearn for greater gifts in 1 Corinthians 12 and that we will show the best way, and then we talk about love from chapter 13.

(1 Corinthians 12:31~13:1) "Desire for greater gifts, and I will also show you the best way. 13:1 Even if I speak in tongues of men and angels, if there is no love, I will be a sounding brass and a ringing trumpet."

The most precious virtue in Christianity is love. If we lose love, we will lose the love between husband and wife, the love between friends, and the love between saints. When the love between the saints gradually cools down, we should pray for repentance. In order for our spirituality to deepen, we must mature with love. No matter how much faith you have, if you don't have love, it's nothing.

☆ Application Question 3

1) (Looking back on this year's ministry and life) I hope you will share how you want to mature with love in your ministry and life at the end of the year.

Answer 4. Burning spirituality is completed by mission.

Missions are the perfection of spirituality.

(Acts 1:8) "But when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, you will receive power and be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth." (Matthew 28:20) "Teach them all that I have commanded you, so that they may keep them, and behold, I will be with you always, even to the end of the world."

Just as Elisha took on God's work through the inspiration he wanted while following Elijah, I pray that we will become a precious church that accomplishes the kingdom of God on this earth through missionary work with fervent spirituality.
