A Treasure Worth Selling Everything For | Matthew 13:44-46

(44) "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then () went and sold all he had and bought that field." (45) "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls." (46) "When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it."

1. Welcome

"Looking back on your walk with God, what is one thing you feel you've done really well?" Share one grace or blessing you received through Grace Time this past week.

2. Sermon Summary

We often become discouraged because we only see the harsh reality before us. Yet even in the midst of that reality, God has hidden the treasures of heaven. Instead of being deceived by what we see, we must have spiritual eyes to recognize God's good purpose hidden within it.

What happens when we discover the Kingdom of Heaven?

① We Enjoy []. (v. 44)

Like those who discovered the treasure hidden in the field and the pearl of great value, those who discover the Kingdom of Heaven realize it is worth giving up everything for. This joy is not completed by our circumstances, but by encountering []. We should also pray that God will help us recognize the treasure of heaven more deeply.

② [] and [] Take Place. (vv. 44, 46)

When we discover the absolute [], the relative [] naturally loses its hold on us. We no longer live by the world's standards, but come to regard the Kingdom of God as our highest [], recognizing the grace of salvation won through the cross of Christ. We begin to consider worldly things as rubbish and seek true satisfaction in Christ alone.

③ We Joyfully []. (vv. 44, 46)

Those who know the value of the Kingdom of Heaven willingly and joyfully []. This is not because they hope to gain something, but because they have already found the greatest treasure. Like Abraham, Moses, Peter, and Mary, we should believe that nothing is more precious than Jesus and live a life of joyful surrender

Those who discover the Kingdom of Heaven live a life of enjoying its blessings. The real question is whether we have truly discovered that treasure. This week, may we confess that nothing is more valuable than Jesus and commit ourselves to a life of joyful surrender.

3. Discussion

- 1) From today's message, "A Treasure Worth Selling Everything For," what spoke to your heart the most?

- 2) Have you found the hidden treasure of God's kingdom, the treasure worth giving up everything to possess? If so, how has it been changing your daily life?

- 3) This week, let's commit to one thing we will joyfully offer to God.
(Examples: our time, possessions, talents, worship, prayer, God's Word, service, evangelism, missions, forgiveness, obedience, or thanksgiving.)

After the discussion, let's spend time in united prayer.
