Fourth week of April: Strive to enter through the narrow gate (Luke 13:23~30)

■ Welcome

If you must go to a very distant place right now, what are the 3 things you would want to pack in your bag? Let's also share one thing you received through last week's Grace Time.

■ Text: Luke 13:23~30

■ Introduction

The text says, "Lord, why are few who are saved?" This is an explanation of the answer when Jesus answered, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate." The word 'narrow' comes from the Greek word 'stenos', which means 'adversity, suffering, and pressure', so 'narrow gate' means 'a difficult road, a path of suffering'.

What does it mean to believers, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate"?

The saints who have been saved by faith must complete their salvation with fear and trembling until they reach the kingdom of heaven, so they are told to "strive to enter through the narrow gate." In the musical "New Pilgrim's Progress" uploaded by the Cultural Ministry, the main character is 'Christian'. It tells the story of him believing in Jesus and setting out on the road to heaven. In the midst of various difficult and difficult situations, Christians escape from the city of despair with the key of the covenant, the "word of promise."

His path to nature was not easy and was constantly accompanied by numerous hardships and sufferings. Through this, it shows that the life of a saint is a series of sufferings both internally and externally. In the end, 'Christians' are sanctified and grow in faith through hardships and adversity. On the way, he meets a co-worker named 'Faith', and at the end, he meets 'Hope' and crosses the river of death together to the front of the Heavenly Gate.

What is particularly emphasized in the musical is the story of a narrow door. The narrow gate is Jesus Christ, and at the same time it symbolizes the eternal kingdom of heaven. The gate of heaven is the narrow gate.

(Matthew 7:14) "The gate that leads to life is narrow, and the way is narrow, so few seek it."

Jesus clearly says that the way to the door of eternal life is a narrow road. Then, let's find out who is the one who goes to the narrow gate, the narrow path.

■ Observation Question: Who goes to the narrow door, the narrow road?



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Answer 1. We are strangers on this earth (verse 13).

In the last part of the musical “New Pilgrim’s Progress”, Christian crosses the river of death and the river of life with a friend named “Hope”. On the other side of the river, you can see the nature. The river flows quietly on the outside, the current is calm, and the depth is about the bottom of the chest, so it is a calm river. However, Christians suddenly fell into the river and could not get out. The reason he fell into the river was because he did not pray. A saint is a person who prays and seeks, and the one who goes to the narrow path in the end means the one who prays.

(1 Thessalonians 5:17~18) **“Pray without ceasing 18 This is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.”**

The musical team prayed because they thought that it was God’s will to ask them to pray until the end. The musical team fasted for 240 days and prayed for the salvation of souls first. It is said that it is because it is a prayer so that we do not miss out on glorifying God.

☸ Application Question 1

1) What was the difference in my life when I missed prayer and when I held on? If you have any specific experiences, please share them.

Answer 2. . He is the one who puts the word into practice.

(verse 24) **“Strive to enter through the narrow gate, I say to you, there will be many who seek to enter but will not be able to enter.”**

When I asked Pastor Kim Kwang-shin, who is a senior pastor, about ‘**what is going through a narrow door or a narrow road?**’, he defined it as ‘**going to the middle of the word**’.

In 119:18, the psalmist confesses. **“Open my eyes to see your wonders”**

This means that when the word comes to us, the Holy Spirit works and the narrow path seems to be wide. Pastor Kim Kwang-shin also told me that once you enter a narrow road, the road is so wide that you can’t think that it is narrow at all.

In Ezekiel chapter 47, there is a vision that the prophet sees. The water from the temple first kicked into the ankles, then became larger and larger, and later became a river that could not be swimmereed in.

When the word comes to me, the Holy Spirit works, and when I put the word into practice, the time of Kairos comes, and the miraculous wonders and miracles of the Lord appear. At such times, your thoughts and perspectives will be broadened. Therefore, we ask whether the road that entered through the narrow door is a narrow road. When you enter into the word and put it into practice, you will know that the path is not a narrow path.



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☸ Application Question 2

1) What is the word you know in your life right now but haven’t put into practice yet?

2) If there is an experience that was too difficult to obey at first and felt like a ‘narrow door’, but when you put it into practice, it saved you and expanded the horizon of your life (Kairos time), please share it

Answer 3. . They are those who give faith.

(verse 30) **“Behold, there are those who are the last, and there are those who are the first, and there are those who are the last.”**

It doesn’t matter how well you believed in the past, what you believe in the present is important. Yesterday my faith was good, but today I don’t have the faith to walk with the Lord, how sad will the Lord be?

In the musical, there is a woman called ‘**chatter**’ who seems to have believed in Jesus in the past. She says that she also believes in Jesus, and she expresses her knowledge of the Bible in words, and she has a heated argument with the role of ‘**faith**’. The ‘**talker**’ is a woman who did not know how hard she used to go to church, but now she is living a life of advocating homosexuality and completely leaving Jesus. For the woman, “**faith**” speaks to Matthew 7:21.

(Matthew 7:21) **“Not everyone who says to me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only those who do the will of my Father who is in heaven.”**

We do not believe in the Lord with knowledge like a ‘**talker**’. Only those who do God’s will can go to heaven. This is because faith is perfected by works (James 2:22). The reason why the ‘**path of faith**’ is a narrow path is because we cannot see it with our eyes. Because there are no immediate results. Because people don’t recognize it. This is because sometimes it is a way to lose money. That’s why many people give up on going down that path.

(Hebrews 11:6) **“Without faith it is impossible to please God, but whoever comes to God must believe that he is and that he is a rewarder to those who seek him.”**

Those who give faith to God are those who walk the narrow path and are pleasing to God.
