4th Week of May: The Spirituality of the Intercessor (Luke 22:31-34)

■ Welcome

Let's share a time when you got help or gave help when you really needed it. And share one of the ways you were blessed by last week's Grace Time.

■ Text: Luke 22:31~34

And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: but I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death. And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knows me.

■ Introduction

Because the values of the Christian faith are spiritual, the world does not understand our gospel beliefs.

On the other hand, saints are those who understand and know spiritual things because they have received Jesus Christ and have an office from heaven. The word intercession refers to establishing relationships, strengthening relationships, and restoring relationships. The model of intercession is our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, because the saints are spiritually alert, they have the mission of intercessors who, in imitation of Jesus Christ, bridge the relationship between God and man.

(1 Timothy 2:5) “For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.”

■ Sharing Question: What does it take to have the spirituality of an intercessor?

Answer 1. Have an intercessor's mission.



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Jesus came to earth in human flesh as a mediator to break down the barrier between God and us, sinners. After fulfilling that mission, he ascended into heaven and is still seated at the right hand of God as the mediator of the saints. He also indwells us as Immanuel, God the Son, and takes up the work of a mediator for us.

(Ephesians 2:14-15) **“And having abolished in his flesh the enmity, the law of commandments, which was in the form of a question, having made in his flesh the two new man, 16 that he might reconcile them both in one body to God by the cross, having destroyed in himself the enmity by the cross.”**

Of all the churches on earth, none is perfect. There was a serpent, Satan, in the Garden of Eden; there was Judas Iscariot among the 12 disciples Jesus prayed over; there were seven deacons in the Jerusalem church who founded the heretical Nicolaitan party. Like faithful Peter, saints can be used by Satan at any moment. Therefore, it is very important to have the mission of an intercessor in the ministry of the church.

Jesus himself teaches his disciples that he will suffer many things, be killed, and rise from the dead on the third day. Jesus, who came as an intercessor, now tells his disciples to fulfill that intercessory mission.

(Matthew 16:21) **“From this time forth Jesus Christ began to teach his disciples that he must go up to Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day rise again.”**

✿ Application Question 1

- 1) Share any fruit of answered intercession for the body together.
- 2) What is the attitude I need to have in my heart to intercede?

Answer 2. Have to have an eye for the spiritual.

Because intercessors have a spiritual mission, they must have a spiritual perspective to fulfill it. Jesus, the model of intercession, saw the invisible in the visible and spoke the invisible in the visible because he had the vision to see spiritual things.

(Matthew 16:16, 23) **“Simon Peter answered and said unto him, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. 23 “And Jesus, turning, said unto Peter, get thee behind me, Satan: for thou art the one that causes me to fall....”**

In verse 23, Jesus calls Peter “Satan” after he correctly professes to be the Son of the living God. Jesus is not speaking to Peter of the visible, but of the invisible and spiritual. In the case of Judas Iscariot, Jesus reveals the invisible and spiritual, that Judas Iscariot was unwittingly led by Satan to sell Jesus.

(John 13:2) **“The devil had already put the idea of selling Jesus into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon.”**



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The church community is not just a community, but a community of spiritual life, a gathering of people called out of the world, born again people, people who have spiritual life in their visible physical life. Therefore, we must have spiritual eyes to see the invisible in our faith. For this we need to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

✿ Application Question 2

- 1) Share an experience where you have struggled with speaking and acting with what you see.
- 2) How and what can we train ourselves to see the invisible instead of reacting to the visible?

Answer 3. Four important principles of an intercessor

*** The four most important principles Pastor Lecturer spoke about during the revival**

① Don't speak with words, speak with the Word!

Words are my thoughts, but God's words are blessed to express God's will.

When we speak, we complain and complain, but when we speak in faith, we receive the grace of God.

② Don't talk, do it with faith!

When we speak, we complain and complain, but when we speak in faith, we receive the grace of God.

③ Don't talk, pray!

Words express the will of man, but if you tune in to God's frequency and pray, you will fulfill God's will.

④ Don't talk, obey!

If we talk, we forget the blessings, but if we obey, we create the blessings that God gives.

This principle is a blessed principle that produces God's blessings because it helps us to live a faithful life without being used by Satan. May you be a blessed saint by applying this principle in your life.

✿ Application Question 3

- 2) Proclaim the four principles together, share prayer requests with each other, and pray together.
