Second Week of July: God Loves America(Psalm 33:12)

■ Welcome

As you reflect on living in the United States, what is the first thing you are most thankful for? Let's also share one thing that brought you grace during last week's Grace Time

■ Text: Psalm 33:12

“Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people He has chosen as His own inheritance.”

■ Introduction

This year marks the 250th anniversary of the United States' independence. Although its history is relatively short, America has experienced remarkable blessings and grace from God. When we consider the freedom, prosperity, and global influence the nation enjoys today, we can recognize God's special guidance throughout its history.

In 1776, the United States declared its independence from Great Britain, then the world's most powerful nation. Over the past 250 years, America has achieved extraordinary growth and has become a global leader in government, economics, science, education, culture, and missionary work. As we reflect on God's faithfulness over these past 250 years, may our hearts be filled with gratitude for His abundant blessings upon this nation.

■ Observation Question: What is the foundation of the blessings America has received?

Answer 1. A Nation Built on Religious Freedom

The first evidence of God's favor toward America is that it was founded by people seeking the freedom to worship Him. In 1620, 102 believers known as the Pilgrims arrived at Plymouth, Massachusetts. Before landing, they entered into **the Mayflower Compact**, making a covenant before God to establish a self-governing community founded on reverence for Him. The Protestant faith of these early settlers became a cornerstone of America's values and institutions. The Declaration of Independence (1776) proclaims that **“all men are created equal”** and **“are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights.”** This reflects the biblical worldview that human rights come not from kings or governments, but from God Himself. The First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution further protects this principle by declaring that **Congress shall make no law establishing a religion or prohibiting the free exercise of religion.**

The 19th-century French political thinker Alexis de Tocqueville, after studying American society, concluded that the nation's remarkable strength and **rapid growth were rooted**



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in its reverence for God.

Of course, America has never been a perfect nation. It has endured painful chapters in its history, including slavery, and has committed many mistakes and sins. Yet one truth remains clear: the nation's foundation was deeply influenced by a reverence for God, and God has graciously blessed a nation that sought to honor Him.

✿ Application Question 1

1) When have you been especially grateful for the religious freedom you enjoy today? What attitudes and responsibilities should we have in order to preserve and faithfully exercise our religious freedom?

Answer 2. God's Blessing Through an Abundantly Blessed Land

Another reason America has grown into a leading nation is the blessing of the land God has given. The United States has often been described as "one of the most richly blessed lands in human history."

First, God provided America with natural protection. The Atlantic Ocean borders the east coast, and the Pacific Ocean borders the west, creating vast natural barriers that have contributed to the nation's security.

Second, God gave America a fertile and productive land. Between the Rocky Mountains and the Appalachian Mountains lie expansive plains with rich soil and abundant rainfall. These natural resources have made the United States one of the world's leading agricultural nations.

Third, God blessed America with abundant natural resources. Oil, natural gas, iron ore, coal, gold, silver, copper, and many other essential resources are found throughout the country, providing a strong foundation for industrial and economic development. The true blessing, however, is not the land itself but the God who graciously provided it.

Answer 3. God's Blessing Through Spiritual Revival

Throughout American history, whenever the nation experienced spiritual decline, God faithfully brought seasons of revival. Through several **Great Awakenings**, He awakened His church, revived believers, and renewed the nation.

First, the Second Great Awakening took place after the American Revolution. During this period, spiritual apathy, secularism, and unbelief spread throughout society. God raised up evangelists such as Charles Finney, who called people to repentance and spiritual renewal.

Second, the 1857 Noon Prayer Revival began during a severe economic crisis. A layman in New York City started a simple lunchtime prayer meeting, which soon spread across the nation and led to widespread revival.

Third, the Azusa Street Revival of 1906 began in a small gathering in Los Angeles led by William J. Seymour, an African American pastor. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully through this revival, accompanied by speaking in tongues, healing, and other spiritual gifts. This movement became the birthplace of the modern Pentecostal movement around the world.



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Fourth, the Jesus Movement of the 1960s and 1970s emerged during a time of social unrest, widespread drug use, and confusion among young people. Through this movement, countless young adults came to faith in Jesus Christ. It remains one of the major roots of today's evangelical movement.

These four revivals share one common theme: whenever America faced its greatest spiritual or national crises, God intervened. Time and again, He brought revival when the nation needed it most.

✿ Application Question 3

1) When your own faith has grown weak or stagnant, how has God brought revival and renewed your spiritual life?

Answer 4. God's Blessing in Using America to Serve the World

God has blessed America not only for its own benefit but also so that it might serve other nations.

First, God used America to help defend the free world. During the first half of the twentieth century, militarism, fascism, and Nazism threatened many nations, and America played a significant role in resisting these forces.

Second, after World War II, God used America to help contain the spread of atheistic communism, which was rapidly expanding throughout many parts of the world.

Third, God has used America as a major sending nation for global missions. Perhaps America's greatest contribution has been the spread of the gospel. Since the nineteenth century, the United States has sent more missionaries than any other nation, helping bring the message of Christ to people around the world.

✿ Application Question 4

1) As a Christian living in America, what role can I play in serving the nations and advancing God's kingdom throughout the world?

Answer 5. God's Blessing Through the Mission to the Nations

The fifth evidence of God's blessing upon America is that He has entrusted this nation with a central role in world missions. God has granted America freedom, prosperity, and revival so that the gospel might be proclaimed to the ends of the earth.

During the twentieth century, the United States became a leading missionary-sending nation. Countless young men and women dedicated their lives to missions, and churches across the country faithfully supported and sent them around the world.

We, in particular, have received a special blessing through American missions. On Easter morning in 1885, two American missionaries, Horace G. Underwood and Henry G. Appenzeller, arrived at the Port of Incheon, marking the beginning of Protestant missionary work in Korea. Through their faithful ministry, the gospel took root and spread throughout our nation. As recipients of this gospel heritage, we have a responsibility to repay our "debt of the gospel" by proclaiming Christ to the nations.

✿ Application Question 5

1) As someone who has received the gospel through the faithfulness of others, what responsibility do I have to share it with those who have not yet heard? To which mission field or outreach opportunity can I commit myself this year?
