2nd Week of November: Let Us Not Relax (Luke 12:35-40)

■ Welcome

When is the day or time when your heart feels most lax? Why? Also, let's share one thing you received grace through during last week's Grace Time.

■ Text: : Luke 12:35-40

35 Let your loins be girded and your lamps burning; 36 and be like men who wait for their master to return from the wedding feast, so that when he comes and knocks they may immediately open to him. 37 Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and he will come and serve them. 38 Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. I tell you the truth, he will fasten his belt around them, have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. 39 You know that if the owner of the house had known

■ Introduction

The Bible warns that a terrible tribulation will come in the last days. On that day of tribulation, the only One we must hold onto is Jesus, the one and only God.

(John 16:33) “I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

Moreover, believers must thoroughly repent for this land.

(2 Chronicles 7:13-14) “...if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

And to prepare for the last days, we must stay awake. That is why the Bible emphasizes the command “Stay awake” no fewer than 22 times. This is a call to awaken from deep spiritual slumber. Believers must awaken from spiritual sleep, discern God's will, and stand firm in faith.

* Why must believers stay awake?

1) To avoid falling into temptation.

(Matthew 26:41) “Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

2) To resist the devil.

(James 4:7) “Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

3) To live a righteous life of faith.



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In Revelation, the Lord rebuked the seven churches of Asia Minor. The church in Sardis appeared outwardly as a church and held worship services, but in the Lord's eyes, it had a dead faith. The church in Laodicea had form but no warmth; it was a church whose passion for faith had grown cold. We are no different today. If we do not remain spiritually awake and live a righteous faith life, we will hear rebuke from God.

4) It is to prepare to meet the Lord.

(Luke 12:40) **"Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man will come at an hour you do not expect."**

The day of the Lord's coming is near. Those who are awake are prepared to welcome the Lord with joy, but those who are not awake will not discern that day and will stand unprepared. Therefore, now is the time to be awake in faith and prepare to welcome the returning Lord.

■ **Observation Question: What attitude must we maintain to live a victorious life?**

Answer 1. We must gird our loins and stay alert.

(Eph 6:14) **"Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm."**

'Girding your loins' means arming yourself with the Word. When prepared with the Word of truth, we can discern trials and overcome deception. Without being armed with the Word, we are easily shaken, but those prepared by the Word can walk the right path in any circumstance.

Daniel saw all the other children eating the king's delicacies, but because he was armed with the Word, he resolved: "I cannot defile my body with food offered to idols." So he guarded himself by eating only vegetables and drinking water. Even when faced with the threat of being thrown into the lions' den for refusing to bow to the idol, the living word of God in his heart enabled Daniel to continue praying to God three times a day without ceasing.

We who live in the last days are no different. Without being armed with the word, we cannot discern the world's temptations.

❁ Application Question 1

- 1) If there are any worldly temptations or untrue thoughts that have recently shaken you, let's share them.
- 2) What must we give up, pursue, and train ourselves in to arm ourselves with the Word?

Answer 2. We must keep our lamps lit and stay awake.

'Lighting the lamp' signifies a spiritually full state of the Holy Spirit. In the parable of the ten virgins in Matthew 25, all ten held lamps awaiting the bridegroom, but only the



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wise five who prepared oil actually met him. That oil is the Holy Spirit. Only when filled with the Holy Spirit can we prepare for the last days and meet the Lord with joy.

(Ephesians 5:18) "Do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit."

A lamp requires constant refilling of oil to keep its flame burning. Being filled with the Holy Spirit is the same. It is not something that ends after a single experience; it must be received daily, moment by moment. When filled with the Holy Spirit, a light is kindled within the soul, and one dwells in spiritual light.

❁ Application Question 2

- 1) What actions or habits in my current life most hinder being filled with the Holy Spirit and consume the oil of my spiritual lamp?
- 2) Since being filled with the Holy Spirit requires 'continuous reception every day, every moment,' what regular spiritual habits are necessary for this?

Answer 3. We must stand and stay awake.

'Standing' refers to the posture of a servant who is always ready to obey the master's call and do as commanded. The church and its saints must always be prepared to obey God's word.

Moreover, the Lord says we are the light of the world. As the conscience of the world, the church must shine its light all the more as the world grows darker. In times of difficulty, the church must rise up in prayer and help neighbors in distress.

(Matthew 5:14) **"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden."**

We remember our faith predecessors who acted in faith. We remember the 17-year-old martyr Yu Gwan-sun who participated in the March First Movement. She became a child of light, resisting injustice and acting as a conscience within God's grace.

When the nation faces crisis, believers must become Christians who pray with tears for their country. "God, all these calamities are because of our sins. Lord, forgive us and heal this land."

Believers must rise up, fasting and praying with courage and faith. We desire our church to be such a church.

❁ Application Question 3

- 1) What areas of obedience do I find difficult or uncomfortable? (e.g., forgiveness, financial sharing, sacrificial service)
- 2) Share a testimony of a time when you immediately responded "Yes" to the Lord's command.
- 3) As the "conscience of the world," where do I desire to shine light into the world's darkness? (e.g., community issues, marginalized groups, national crises, mission fields, etc.)
