Family church worship plan 2026. 2. 8

2nd Week of February: Transform the World as a Church that Received Grace (Daniel 9:23)

■ Welcome

Let's share what we want to challenge, conquer, master, or try this year. Also, let's share one of the gracious things we received through last week's Grace Time.

■ Text: Daniel 9:23

“As soon as you began to pray, a word went out, which I have come to tell you, for you are highly esteemed. Therefore, consider the word and understand the vision.”

■ Introduction

We long for God's Favor, special grace. The person officially recognized in the Bible as “one who received grace (Hamudot - meaning: God's treasure, deeply beloved one, person where Heaven's heart resides)” is Daniel. This is Heaven's official title given to those who are deeply loved and entrusted with Heaven's confidence.

This title came to Daniel while he was fasting, repenting, and praying, embracing the sins of his nation. He wept and repented of his nation's sins as if they were his own and his family's. The same scene repeats in the New Testament. The angel says to Mary: “You who are highly favored.” Heaven responds in the same way to those who humbly accept God's will without avoiding it.

Grace is Heaven's decision to trust a person's life and use them to the end. Daniel was a captive, but in Heaven, he was a missionary. He was not a person who was dragged away, but one who was sent. God placed him in the heart of the empire for his entire life, gave him the mission of prime minister, and used him to the end. God is not one who removes problems from the reality of those who receive grace, but rather makes them break through in that place and fulfill God's will and vision. In Daniel's life, three distinct graces appear - Be fruitful. Conquer. Rule.

■ Observation Question: What are the three graces God gave to Daniel?

Answer 1. Grace of Fullness (Male) - Deciding to Fear Only God

Before giving him a mission, God first filled not his external environment but his inner being. This is Male. Male is the state of a soul filled with God's presence. The Bible records a decision that changed Daniel's life:

(Dan 1:8) **"But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself this way."**

His decision before the king's food was not simply restraint, but a declaration of identity, **"I am a person who belongs to God,"** and a **"worshiper's decision"** to fear God. He decided not to compromise with his environment and not to defile himself. Daniel did not fear people nor the empire's power. The only One he feared was the LORD God. Therefore, God's presence always dwelt in his life. Fear calls presence, and presence fills the soul. This is the secret of Male.

The lion's den incident is a story from Daniel's old age, around 80 years old. The life centered on fear and worship that began in his youth did not change until his old age. He decided to fear God, that fear brought presence, and that presence filled his soul throughout his life.

❁ Application Question 1

- 1) Among my recent decisions, what choice did I make "because I feared God more"?
- 2) Just as Daniel kept his youthful decision until age 80, what decision should I establish and keep before God this year?

Answer 2. Obey God's Word (Verse 12)

Those who are awake break through with prayer. If Male is the grace of being filled with God, Kabash is the grace where that fullness breaks through and manifests through reality's barriers. A person filled with God ultimately does not get pressed down before circumstances. They inevitably penetrate through those circumstances. Kabash is the breakthrough of faith that passes through the midst of oppression through prayer.

1) Breakthrough before a life-threatening crisis (Daniel 2)

King Nebuchadnezzar declared he would kill everyone if they could not reveal his dream and its interpretation. At that moment, Daniel immediately came to God. God showed him the dream and its interpretation. He was a person who drew Heaven's power through prayer. This is Kabash.

2) Breakthrough where prayer was forbidden (Daniel 6)

The most dramatic breakthrough in Daniel occurs before the lion's den. A trap targeting Daniel created a law: "pray and you die." However, because Daniel was a man of prayer, the lion's den could not swallow Daniel. Rather, it became a place revealing God's glory. Kabash is a life that penetrates problems through prayer.

3) Breakthrough of repentant prayer embracing the nation (Daniel 9)

Daniel's Kabash did not end with personal survival. He opened the Word and saw the nation's time - the captivity would end in 70 years (Dan 9:2). He first knelt down and prayed repentance, embracing the nation. But amazingly, God also showed him the secrets of the last days. Kabash is not the power to survive. It is the grace of breakthrough that penetrates crises through prayer and opens even the nation and the last age through repentance.

Answer 3. Grace of Governance (Rada) - Revealing God's Reign

Male is filling. Kabash is breakthrough. The final grace, Rada, is their ultimate purpose - a life that reveals God's reign. Rada is a life that makes God's will the standard on this earth. Daniel became a person who was used and respected to the end through four kings in the empire where he was taken captive.

The places where Daniel stood were important empires in world history. The only reason he could shine there was because he was Heaven's vice-regent. He governed with only God's will as the standard. The sovereign of history is not man, but God. Empires shake, but God's reign does not shake. Biblical Rada is a life that reflects God's order.

External success and influence are also important. But true Rada is internal order - the order of prayer, Word-centeredness, attitude of fearing God. Because that order did not collapse in Daniel, God shook empires through him. God wants us today to also long for this grace, look not at visible reality but at Heaven's will, and live a year fulfilling Heaven's vision in our respective places.

(Example) William Wilberforce (1759-1833)

A 19th-century British Christian politician who dedicated his life to leading the abolition of slave trade and slavery in Britain. After over 20 years of persistent struggle, he passed the Slave Trade Act in 1807, and in 1833, just before his death, saw the fruit of completely abolishing the slave system within Britain.
