Family church worship plan 2026. 1. 11

2nd Week of January: Let Us Become a Church That Fills, Conquers, and Rules the World. (Genesis 1:26-28)

■ Welcome

If you have had a very successful outcome from a New Year's resolution you made in the past, please share it. Also, let's share one of the gracious things we received through last week's Grace Time.

■ Text: Genesis 1:26-28

26 Then God said, “Let us make humankind in our image, after our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the wild animals of the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.” 27 So God created humankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. 28 God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

■ Introduction

This year's motto for our church remains the same as last year's: “All Generations United to the Ends of the Earth.” The theme verse is Psalm 145:4: “All generations shall praise Your deeds and declare Your mighty acts.”

Here, “all generations” refers to successive generations. Our vision is for every generation—first, second, third... the elderly and middle-aged, youth and the next generation, even children—to carry on faith and ministry together, praising the Lord and uniting to fulfill world missions.

Last year, our church experienced the grace of having over 1,540 members participate in short-term missions. While primarily adults, this included children from the Education Department and the English Ministry. This year too, we will continue running toward this global mission goal, united across all generations.

The word the Lord gave our church, carrying this mission forward, on the first Sunday of the new year is Genesis 1:26-28. God commands humanity, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over it.” This word proclaims the mission and responsibility God entrusted to humanity within His created world. It is God's will for all mankind and a blessed word giving our church, which carries the gospel and advances into the world, a clear purpose and vision.

■ Observation Question: What is God's will for all humanity?

Answer 1. Be Fruitful and Multiply.

This command signifies humanity's biological flourishing and spreading across the entire earth. Indeed, since Adam and Eve, humanity has increased exponentially. Though humanity faced judgment through Noah's Flood, today approximately 8 billion people inhabit the earth.

However, God's original purpose was not fulfilled due to sin entering the world. When God commanded humanity to fill the earth, He desired it to be filled with people bearing His image and obeying His will. Yet, with sin's entrance, people became slaves to sin, worshiped idols, and evil filled the world. The fullness God desired was for the world to be filled with people reflecting His character. It is the fullness where God's rule and glory are revealed over all the earth.

To restore this purpose, the Lord gave the church a new command.

(Matthew 28:18-20) **"Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.'"**

Believers, as God's people, must hope to be filled and must preach the gospel today.

(2 Tim 4:2) **"Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season."**

❖ Application Question 1

Answer 2. Subdue.

'Subdue' (Hebrew: kabash) does not mean 'to destroy or oppress.' It means to discover the order and potential already present within God's created world and to use it well to establish a foundation for life. In other words, it is God's command to transform chaos into order.

This subduing is not grandiose; it encompasses every effort to untangle what is knotted, fix what is uncomfortable, and make what is dangerous safe. In today's terms, it speaks of the responsibility to advance scholarship and technology, establish art and culture, and make society a better place to live.

The subduing commanded by God is a call to set the world right together with God, a sacred mission to reveal God's wisdom and glory on this earth.

In 1975, Bill Bright (founder of CCC) and Loren Cunningham (founder of YWAM) identified seven core areas of society where Christians should demonstrate biblical values and positive influence.

Christians are called to be everyday missionaries in their respective workplaces. Therefore, they must conquer the ground in their own spheres. They must make the influence of Jesus Christ visible right where they are. That place will become ground where God's reign is established.

❖ Application Question 2

- 1) If there are areas in my life that have become chaotic, let's share them.

Answer 3. Have Dominion.

'To rule' (Hebrew: lada) signifies governance as a good steward, not violent domination. Humans are not masters of the world but stewards entrusted to care for it on behalf of God, the true Master. Just as a king cares for his people, humans bear the responsibility to protect and manage creation so each may thrive according to its purpose.

Until the day the Lord returns to personally rule the entire world, we must live so that God's governance is revealed in our lives, society, and nation.

* How can we achieve this kind of governance?

1. Creating Value Through Expertise

The starting point of 'ruling' is mastering one's profession to the highest level. Every believer has received the same calling in their respective life spheres. The Puritans viewed every occupation as a 'holy calling' given by God and believed it was a tool to please Him. Those who fear God must use their expertise to sustain this world and build civilization.

2. Establishing Biblical Standards

It means upholding biblical standards against corrupt and decadent trends within the society we inhabit and our respective spheres. Christians are not people who live apart from the world, but those who live as light and salt right in the midst of it. When God's standards are established in each person's sphere in this way, God's rule comes upon that sphere.

- 1) To govern, first recognize that I am a 'steward.' What must I relinquish to properly embrace this stewardship mindset?
- 2) Let us intercede for one another (sharing our fields and lives) that this year our lives and ministries may become God's reign by establishing His standards as the light and salt of the world.
